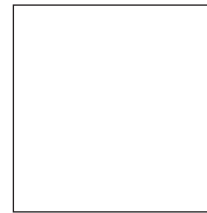

LBCC is committed to creating a safe and nurturing educational center in which families, teachers and staff are in partnership. We provide an environment that enables each child to grow physically, intellectually, emotionally, culturally and socially. We value every child and do all that we can to ensure that they reach their maximum potential.

## Diversity

We are proud of the diversity of our families, teachers and staff. With families and children from 17 different countries and from many communities in Westchester, life at the Center is rich with multicultural experiences and activities.

Based upon observation and assessment of each child, we develop curricula to address all areas of competency: language, cognitive, social, emotional and physical development. The heart of our educational program is the growth and learning of our children. Our goal is to ensure that each child is well prepared for kindergarten and has the skills and knowledge to achieve in school. Thus, we integrate literacy into all that we do with the children. For the youngest children, we provide sensory stimulation and nurturing. In the pre-school classes, we expose children to letters and numbers and encourage them to read, write and communicate. Children learn through multiple media and we utilize various learning and art materials, as well as music and dramatic play to stimulate each child's receptive and expressive language.

Our teacher to child ratios exceed

State standards:

- ▶ Infants: 1 to 4
- ▶ Toddlers: 1 to 5
- ▶ Threes and Fours: 1 to 8

At LBCC our staff of licensed professionals performs or refers children for assessments to determine the need for Early Intervention (EI) and provide or connect families to the appropriate supports.

- ▶ Full Day Program: for infants (starting at 6 weeks old), toddlers & pre-schoolers from 7:30am-6:00pm
- ▶ School Age Enrichment Program: before and after school, school closings, holidays and summer camp for children 6-12
- ▶ Stepping Stones: provides speech, occupational therapy, physical therapy, counseling, and family training
- ▶ Westchester Arts Council's Artists-in- Residence Programs and Music Conservatory of Westchester include: international music, drumming, mosaics and photography
- ▶ Nutritious meals including: breakfast, hot lunch and an afternoon snack
- ▶ Health: RN onsite; hearing and vision screening; health education
- ▶ Arts & Music: integrated into the curriculum for all children, enhanced by visiting artists
- ▶ Swimming, Tennis, and Gymnastics: rotating schedule of lessons and activities
- ▶ Trips: educational, cultural & recreational
- ▶ Limited transportation

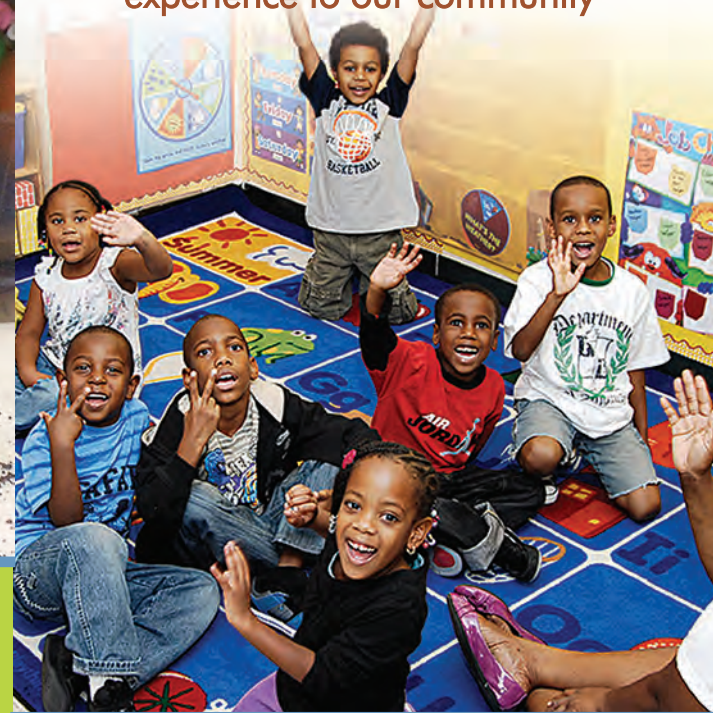
